



Characteristics and Purpose:

- The "Blended e-learning course to prepare for the Project Manager certification exam" was designed by A4PM® by defining the elements of knowledge considered necessary to consolidate a professional path as a Project Manager and for those who operate in various title in a project context, aligning with the only international standard that defines project management guidelines, such as ISO 21502:2021 and the Italian Standard UNI 11648:2022.
- The UNI ISO 21502 standard is already included in the new edition of the "Codice degli Appalti" (Legislative Decree no. 36 of 31 March 2023) while the certification of project managers according to UNI 11648 has already been a preferential requirement in public procurement tenders for some years.
- The training contents of the course are recognized by Certification Bodies (CB) for the purposes of admission to the Project Manager certification exam (according to UNI 11648:2022) and registration in the relevant third-party national register of recognized Project Managers from ACCREDIA.

Duration: 35 hours + 3 hours of virtual training

Course design

Since the discipline of project management is certainly aimed at a specific type of student, the adult worker, the limited and fragmented availability of time that this category of students has must be taken into account. So, **after of a research study carried out in recent years**, evaluating how distance learning is carried out for adults, both in Italy and abroad (**Cambridge University**), we have investigated all the issues of the case and we worked to structure the solution suitable for the category of this type of student.

Duration and access to Courses:


Certification path defined by ACCREDIA:

REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Minimum high school diploma requirement

Project Management Training: At least 35 hours of Project Management training. (requirement starting from the 2022 version of UNI11648)

Experience: at least two years as Project Manager in the last 6 years or having carried out Project Management activities for at least 3 years plus at least 1 year as Project Manager in the last 10 years



- **1. §A.2 Non-formal learning:** it is believed that 35 credits in the project management discipline can be acquired following a 35-hour course previously recognized in the preliminary phase by the Certification Body, in relation to the content programme;
- 2. §A.2 Informal learning: work experience must be documented, the mere presentation of a self-declaration pursuant to Presidential Decree 445/2000 or a Curriculum vitae without proving documentation are not sufficient to satisfy the requirement. As further support, the candidate is also required to present a project report, of which the candidate has acted as Project Manager, according to the indications in Appendix C of UNI 11648:2022:
- 3. §A.3 Applicable assessment methods: the knowledge and skills assessment exam must include:
 - a written test with at least 50 closed-ended questions of which for 4 answers only 1 is correct (those of the "true/false" type are
 excluded). The maximum duration of the test is established at 90 minutes. The test is considered passed with a minimum score of 70%,
 i.e. a score equal to or greater than 35/50).
 - a written test with at least 4 open-ended questions, or case studies, applications or simulations of real operational situations related to
 the professional activity or a combination of them. The test lasts 90 minutes. The test is considered passed with a positive evaluation of
 at least 70%. Please remember that the minimum duration of the 2 written tests cannot be less than 180 minutes;
 - an oral test with at least n. 3 questions necessary to investigate any uncertainties found in the written tests, ascertain the level of skills acquired by the candidate, investigate the project report presented by the candidate in the preliminary phase. The test is considered passed with a positive evaluation of at least 70%.

Certification bodies recognized by ACCREDIA certify the skills of the Project Manager, pursuant to the UNI 11648:2016 standard, according to the scheme accredited by ACCREDIA.

Below is a summary table of the main CBs, which are constantly growing, which we recommend analyzing updated on the ACCREDIA website.

Each CB adopts its own independent commercial policies, in fact costs must be considered for:

- the preliminary investigation phase
- take the two written tests and the oral test
- be included in the public register of certified persons of the CB
- the renewal, surveillance and maintenance of certification

The A4PM® course has been qualified by ACS, an OdC (Certification Body) recognized by ACCREDIA and is present in the database of qualified courses with the register number 43, in the three modes in which A4PM® has specialized over the years:

Certification path proposed by A4PM®



A4PM® is a corporate member of the Italian Project Manager Association "ASSOPM", therefore by virtue of this support and promotion of the association, in order to promote project management training, the professional qualification of project managers and disseminate project management certifications AC-PM® offers its students, following the 35-hour course in question, a certification path with exclusive economic benefits and benefits:

Initial phase of investigation

The candidate who wishes to start and complete the certification process provided by ACCREDIA must submit to the Certification Body his or her "curriculum vitae" supplemented by documentation proving the work and training activities declared by the candidate. The analysis of the curriculum vitae must be accompanied by a project report, of which the candidate has acted as project manager.

a) Multiple choice questions written test

The first test is a written test consisting of:

- 60 multiple choice questions.
- Each question has 4 answers of which only one is correct and three are wrong.
- The maximum time available for carrying out the test is 90 minutes.

To pass the written test it is necessary to correctly answer 42 questions out of 60 (70%). Only correct answers count in the counting. The test certifies possession of project management knowledge in reference to the UNI ISO 21502:2021 standard.

b) Open-ended written test

The second test is a written test consisting of:

- 10 closed questions on knowledge of the reference regulatory framework
- 5 open-ended project scenario or case study questions.
- Each closed question is assigned a score of 1 for each correct answer. Only correct answers count in the counting.
- Each open question or scenario analysis or project case is assigned a score of 4, decreased in the case of incomplete answers.
- The maximum time available to carry out the test is 90 minutes.
- The maximum score that can be obtained from the test is 30 points.

To pass the written test it is necessary to obtain at least 21 points out of 30 (70%). The test certifies possession of the skills required for a project manager in reference to the UNI 11648:2022 standard.

As hoped, the student, following the 35-hour course in question, will be able to become a member of ASSOPM for FREE and have 35 training credits immediately recognized (35 of the 60 that ACCREDIA requires to be accrued in the five-year period), will be able to take the couple of written tests, directly with ASSOPM, both considered like A-PM® & C-PM® certifications exam at an agreed cost of €190.00 (instead of €290.00, special rate for participants in courses provided by A4PM®), thus availing themselves following their passing of the certifications in Project Management A-PM® and C-PM® (in the table below, named AC-PM®)with which you will be able to have directly access to the oral exam with a Certification Body recognized by ACCREDIA.

In fact, candidates who, at the time of requesting certification, possess other professional project management qualifications are entitled to a reduction in the number of exam tests. The following table defines the qualifications admitted and the exams to be taken:

The oral test will be carried out with a Certification Body recognized by ACCREDIA, providing at least n. 3 questions necessary for:

- to investigate any uncertainties found in the written tests,
- to ascertain the level of skills acquired by the candidate,
- to delve into the project report presented by the candidate during the preliminary phase.

The test is considered passed with a positive evaluation of at least 70%.





Certification path proposed by A4PM®

Examination tests:

The exams are held remotely via the Goole Meet platform with the presence of a supervisor.

The exam is recorded via the Google Meet platform and supervised with screen sharing, moreover, the examiner will be able to observe the progress of the exam and the behavior of the candidate, with the use of the webcam of his smartphone.

During the tests the use of:

- An electronic calculator
- Using a blank Word page on your PC to take notes during the exam. The Word page cannot be saved in any way and at the end of the test it
 must be closed without saving.

The supervisor's duties are:

- · Verify the identity of the candidate using a valid identification document.
- Verify the suitability of the workstation from which the candidate carries out the exam, verifying the absence of foreign objects and requesting their removal if necessary.
- · Request screen sharing during the test.
- Verify the smooth running of the tests, in accordance with these regulations, and in particular the observance of the prohibitions that he will list before the start of the tests.

Prohibitions

- It is forbidden to use any writing support (sheets, post-its, block-notes, etc.) with the exception of those allowed
- The presence of other people during the exam is prohibited
- · It is forbidden to look outside the screen
- The use of headphones of any type is prohibited
- It is forbidden to turn off the webcam of the PC and smartphone
- The use of double screens is prohibited
- It is forbidden to have applications other than Google Meet and Google Forms open on your PC
- The use of the smartwatch is prohibited
- It is forbidden to get up from your seat during the exam
- It is forbidden to use your smartphone and move it from its position
- It is forbidden to ask questions of the supervisor during the exam.
