REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCESSING THE EXAMINATION:

- possession of the ISIPM-Base® Certificate
- certificate of participation in an advanced project management course of at least 3 days (minimum 24 hours with an accredited body).
- be an ordinary member of ISIPM for the current year;
- have paid the exam registration fee.

Goals:

- The ISIPM-AV® course provides advanced knowledge on the subject of Project Management. An advanced course in project management, theoretical and practical, designed for those who want to sharpen their technical, methodological, managerial, behavioural and contextual knowledge that is essential to project management.
- The course is aimed at the same time to provide preparation required to take the Institute's ISIPM-AV® qualification exam Project Management® Italian.

Contents:

- Context of the project: definitions and concepts, relationships between the
 environment/organizational context and the project, relationships between the project
 and the management of change and benefit realization, environment and project
 governance, project evaluation, stakeholder and project organization, project
 management in relation to current processes, skills of project personnel, project and
 product life cycle, project assumptions and constraints, management of project and
 processes.
- Project management processes, tools and techniques: Process Groups and thematic groups, interactions between process groups:
 - project initiation project charter development, stakeholder identification, creation of the project team.
 - o project planning development of project plans, scope definition, creation of the Work Breakdown Structure (WBS), development of the time schedule (knowledge and application of reticular techniques, of the CPM method, of the Gantt diagram), cost estimation methods, resource planning and estimating (levelling and optimization of resources), budget development, identification of risks, assessment and risk response planning, planning quality, planning, procurement planning, planning of communication.
 - project execution project work direction, project management stakeholders, project team development, risk treatment (risk response), quality assurance, selection of suppliers, distribution (dissemination) of project information.
 - o project control control of project work, (integrated) change control, scope control, resource control, project team management, time schedule and cost control, risk control, quality control, procurement administration (management), communications management, methods of detecting the status of progress, knowledge and application of the Earned Value method, final estimates.
 - o **project closure** closure of a phase or project, collection of lessons learned.
- Behavioural knowledge: characteristics and skills to exercise leadership effectiveness, extrinsic and intrinsic motivation and their influence on goal orientation, team working/team building and project team establishment process, main types of negotiation to be applied with the interlocutors, different approaches to apply for conflict resolution, problem solving techniques, ethics such as social responsibility and respect for stakeholder interests.



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Course design

Since the discipline of project management is certainly aimed at a specific type of student, the adult worker, the limited and fragmented availability of time that this category of students has must be taken into account. So, after of a research study carried out in recent years, evaluating how distance learning is carried out for adults, both in Italy and abroad (Cambridge University), we have investigated all the issues of the case and we worked to structure the solution suitable for the category of this type of student.

Duration and access to Courses:
